MARKET ACCESS SECRETARIATE FOOD INDUSTRY UPDATES

Changes to Hong Kong's Meat Import Protocol

The Market Access Secretariat (MAS) would like to inform establishments involved in the export of meat products (beef, mutton, pork and poultry) to Hong Kong of a change in import protocol.

Canadian slaughterhouses, cutting plants, processing plants and cold storage establishments involved in the export of beef, mutton, pork or poultry products to Hong Kong will now need to be approved by the Canadian Food

Inspection Agency (CFIA) and the Centre for Food Safety (CFS). The new import protocol will be effective as of July 1.

All <u>federally registered</u> Canadian slaughterhouses, cutting plants, processing plants and cold storage establishments, as of December 31, 2023, have already been approved by the Hong Kong's Centre for Food Safety (CFS) to export beef, mutton, pork, and poultry products to Hong Kong. No action is required on the part of these establishments.

DID YOU KNOW?

Food Importers: You Need a Safe Food for Canadians Licence

If you are importing manufactured foods into Canada, then you need a Safe Food for Canadians (SFC) licence.

Starting February 12, 2024, all imported manufactured foods being imported into Canada must have a SFC licences and will be automatically checked at the border.

Without a valid SFC licence, shipments will be denied entry into Canada.
