#### Water

Water is pumped from Lake Winnipegosis to a dugout reservoir. From the reservoir, it is chlorinated and fed to a centrally located pumphouse. Piped distribution exists in most of the community.

#### Waste Disposal

There is a solid-waste disposal site located near the community and shared with Shoal River Indian Reserve.

A low-pressure sewage collection system transfers sewage to a lagoon for treatment.

# Schools

Frontier School Division operates the Pelican Rapids School in the community. The Reserve (Sapotaweyak Cree Nation) has its own school. Staff include the principal, two support staff. Phone (204) 587-2131.
