REGULATION 204/87 R -2

GUIDELINES

Where an application is made to the board for an exemption from any provision of *The Farm Lands Ownership Act*, the board may give favourable consideration to applicants or to acquisitions of land that meet the following guidelines:

- a) the applicant is a non-resident but intends to take up residence in Manitoba within a reasonable period of time;
- b) the applicant is a resident who plans to leave the province temporarily and to return within a reasonable period of time;
- c) the applicant is a religious, charitable or non-profit organization;
- d) the applicant is a non-resident who resides and farms within ten miles of the Manitoba border;
- e) the acquisition of farm land by the applicant is likely to confer a significant benefit on the province;
- f) the acquisition of farm land by the applicant is in the public interest.
