Manitoba – Ukraine Agriculture Trade in 2021



Ukraine Facts

- Capital: Kyiv
- Geography: 603,550 sq km
- GDP per capita: \$4,766 CAD

What Major Agricultural Products Does Ukraine Produce?

- Ukraine produces grain (wheat, corn, barley, rye), oilseeds (sunflower, soy, canola), sugar beets, vegetables, poultry and dairy.
- In 2021, Ukraine exported more than \$35B CAD in agricultural products globally.
- Other important industries include coal, electric power, ferrous and nonferrous metals, machinery and transport equipment, and chemicals.

Manitoba-Ukraine Trade

- In 2021, Manitoba exported a total value of \$3.1M to Ukraine including machinery, agriculture and agri-food products, chemicals, metals, plastic and rubber. Agriculture and agri-food products account for 24 per cent of total exports.
- Manitoba agriculture agri-food exports to Ukraine totalled \$1.6M in 2021. The main Manitoba export category was fish products totaling \$712K.
- Manitoba imports of agri-food products from Ukraine saw an important increase in 2021, reaching \$2.96M which account for 55 per cent of total imports. In 2021, 99 per cent of the agri-food imports were due to millet totaling \$2.93M.

Canada-Ukraine Free Trade Agreement: CUFTA

- Ukraine remains an important economic partner to Canada. In 2016, Canada and Ukraine signed a bilateral Free Trade Agreement ("CUFTA"), eliminating tariffs across many export groups & bringing improved market access
- The largest Ukraine's tariff reductions took place for preparations of vegetables, fruit, nuts, preparations of cereals and flour, cocoa preparations and confectionery, beverages, apparel and textiles, soap and cosmetics and cereals
