

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

- There is currently no industrial scale soybean crushing in Manitoba.
- Canada grows over 5.7 million acres of soybeans each year producing over 6 million tonnes.
- Manitoba is the country's 2nd largest producer of soybeans averaging 22% of Canada's total acres.
- Manitoba is the top hog producing province in Canada driving demand for soybean meal.
- In 2019, there were 3.4 million hogs in Manitoba. This number is expected to grow as domestic hog processing expands.
- Manitoba pork production and processing capacity is rapidly growing due to expansion in operations with Hy-Life and Maple Leaf Foods.
- Manitoba imports nearly 30 million litres of biodiesel each year.
- Higher biodiesel content will require 70 million litres of biodiesel annually by 2022.
