Under this plan, Manitoba is building a strong foundation to create clean, green economic opportunities, support low-carbon growth and innovation, attract new investment and improve business competitiveness. Our vision is for Manitoba to become Canada's cleanest, greenest, and most climateresilient province.

Made-in-Manitoba Carbon Price Saves Money

The Made-in-Manitoba Plan proposes a low and level, Made-in-Manitoba carbon price of \$25 per tonne – half the price of what Ottawa proposes. In 2022, gasoline, diesel, and natural gas prices will all be **HALF** the price of what they would have been under the federal carbon tax plan.



Jobs Pillar

The environment and economy go hand–in-hand. That is why the Made-in-Manitoba Climate and Green Plan has a Jobs Pillar that focuses on four priority areas, known as Keystones, to help create new jobs and economic growth for Manitobans.



Carbon Revenue

At \$25 per tonne, Manitoba's carbon price is estimated to generate about \$260 million in annual revenue. This new carbon revenue will be redirected back to people and the economy to achieve Manitoba priorities. Revenue recycling options being considered include investing in green projects, business competitiveness, clean technologies and green job training, as well as protecting low and middle-income households.
