Notice to Move Out



UPON COMPLETION OF THIS FORM the unit will be offered to the next applicant. As per Section 54 (1) (c) of The Residential Tenancies Act, a landlord may enter the unit without notice for the purpose of showing the unit to a prospective tenant. However, we will make every attempt to notify you prior to showing the unit.

- One full month of notice is required before terminating the tenancy. Notice must be given <u>prior</u> to the first day of the month the tenancy will be terminated.
- All keys and access cards must be returned to Manitoba Housing prior to vacating.
- Vacating guidelines to be completed prior to vacating.
- A unit condition report must be completed with your Manitoba Housing staff prior to vacating.
