This form must be

- completed in its entirety;
- signed by the member's spouse, former spouse or former common-law partner;
- witnessed:
- filed with the administrator; and
- used for funds in a PRPP subject to The Pooled Registered Pension Plan (Manitoba) Act.

Definitions for the Purpose of this Waiver

Administrator means the administrator of the applicable pooled registered pension plan.

Common-law partner of an individual means

- (a) a person who, with the individual, registered a common-law relationship under section 13.1 of *The Vital Statistics Act*; or
- (b) a person who, not being married to the individual, cohabited with him or her in a conjugal relationship
 - (i) for a period of at least three years, if either of them is married, or
 - (ii) for a period of at least one year, if neither of them is married.

Member means a person with a PRPP account subject to *The Pooled Registered Pension Plans (Manitoba) Act.*
