The **New Nation** reported the activities of Louis Riel's provisional government and was published weekly from January 7, 1870 to September 3, 1870. The January 28 issue reports the details of the meetings of the Council of 40, and the March 16 issue reproduces the letter (in French and English) of the President of the Provisional Government. A microfilm copy of the newspaper is available for consultation at the Legislative Library. The entire newspaper **New Nation** is also available online at Manitobia.
