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Introduction



Throughout history, generations of immigrants have arrived in Manitoba to forge a new life. Their multicultural presence is alive and celebrated in our communities. New immigrants and a large number of Manitoba-born residents continue to identify strong ethnic ties outside of Canada. This extended and renewed sense of belonging promotes cultural and ethnic diversity in our province.

Ethnicity is a complex phenomenon. This series of publications helps to capture part of that complexity by outlining essential demographic dimensions of this phenomenon in recent years. Based on selected socio-demographic characteristics such as country of birth, mother tongue, population group and ethnic origins, extracted from the Canadian censuses of population 2001 and 2006, the series covers current trends in Manitoba's regions as well as Winnipeg's community areas.

The ethnicity series is comprised of three volumes:

1. Foreign-born Population

This volume presents the population by country of birth. It focuses on the foreign-born population and its recent, regional distribution across Manitoba. Counted every census year, the foreign-born population is considered as the immigrant population.

2. Population by Mother Tongue

This volume presents the mother tongues of Manitobans, regardless of their immigrant status. It focuses on non-official foreign languages in Manitoba's regions.

3. Population Groups and Ethnic Origins

This volume consists of two parts. The first presents Manitoba's population groups according to visible and non-visible minority self-identification, regardless of immigrant status. It provides details about visible minority groups in Manitoba. The second part shows the census responses about ethnic origins of Manitobans, regardless of their immigrant status.



Manitoba Foreign-born Population

In 2006, Canada's foreign-born population represented about one in five (19.8 per cent) of the total population. This was the highest proportion since 1931, when 22.2 per cent of the population was foreign-born. In 2006, Canada also had the fifth highest percentage of foreign-born population among the 30 member countries of the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), after Luxembourg (34.8 per cent), Australia and Switzerland (24.1 per cent each) and New Zealand (21.2 per cent).


From 1991 to 2006, Manitoba continued having the fourth highest foreign-born population in the country (from 12 to 14 per cent) –after Ontario (23 to 28 per cent); British Columbia (from 24 to 27 per cent); and Alberta (from 15 to 16 per cent).

In 2001 and 2006, the Philippines and United Kingdom were the top source countries of Manitoba's foreign-born population.




Manitoba Regions


From 2001 to 2006, the foreign-born population (as a percentage of their regional population) increased in most Manitoba regions, except in the Parklands and Interlake regions. In 2001, Winnipeg and Parklands

registered the highest percentages of foreign-born population. In 2006, Winnipeg continued to have the highest percentage of people born outside of Canada, followed by the Eastern and Central regions.





Eastern Region: Foreign-born Population by Place of Birth (Top 5)

- From 2001 to 2006, the foreign-born population increased 48.9 per cent (from 7,070 to 10,525).
- In 2001, the top places of birth of this population were Germany and the United States (813 each); Mexico and the United Kingdom (778 each); and Russia (488).
- In 2006, Paraguay (1,890); Germany (1,695) and Mexico (1,130) were, again, the top source countries.
























