

**Newsprint Market Price - July 2013**  
**used to determine August 2013 Crown timber dues**

Crown timber dues will be set monthly based on the previous month's average commodity prices (\$US) as published in *Pulp and Paper Weekly (RISI)* .

1. To determine the Crown Dues Rate (price/m<sup>3</sup>) use the "Price \$CDN 30lbs East \$/tonne" average for the month.
