These 31 professions are controlled by self-regulatory bodies (listed below).



It is their job to set requirements for becoming a member and to discipline members who break the rules.



To work in these professions in Manitoba, you need to apply, be assessed and licensed by the self-regulatory body that is responsible.



There are 125+ other regulated occupations in Manitoba. Most are regulated by the government of Manitoba.




