

## Rent Assist Rates for Homeowners

Rent Assist rates are set according to the cost of rental housing in Manitoba, which changes every year. If the cost of rental housing increases, the Rent Assist Supplement for eligible homeowners will also go up. If the cost of rental housing goes down or stays the same, the Rent Assist Supplement for eligible homeowners will not change.

This adjustment in rates will occur in July each year.

Effective July 2025, Rent Assist rates for homeowners will be as follows:

<b>1 person (GA ONLY)</b>	\$243	\$358
<b>1 person (ALL OTHER CATEGORIES)</b>	\$243	\$442
<b>2 persons (couples or single adult with one child)</b>	\$285	\$501
<b>3 persons</b>	\$310	\$650
<b>4 persons</b>	\$351	\$609
<b>5 persons</b>	\$371	\$740
<b>6 persons</b>	\$387	\$724
<b>Each additional persons (add to 6 person rate)</b>	\$23	--
