

Manitoba Take Home Naloxone Program

SAVING LIVES SINCE 2017

Naloxone is a medication that can temporarily reverse the effects of an opioid overdose or poisoning.

Take home naloxone kits are available for free to members of the public at risk of opioid toxicity and to their family and friends.

The first and most important step in a suspected opioid overdose or poisoning is to **call 911**.

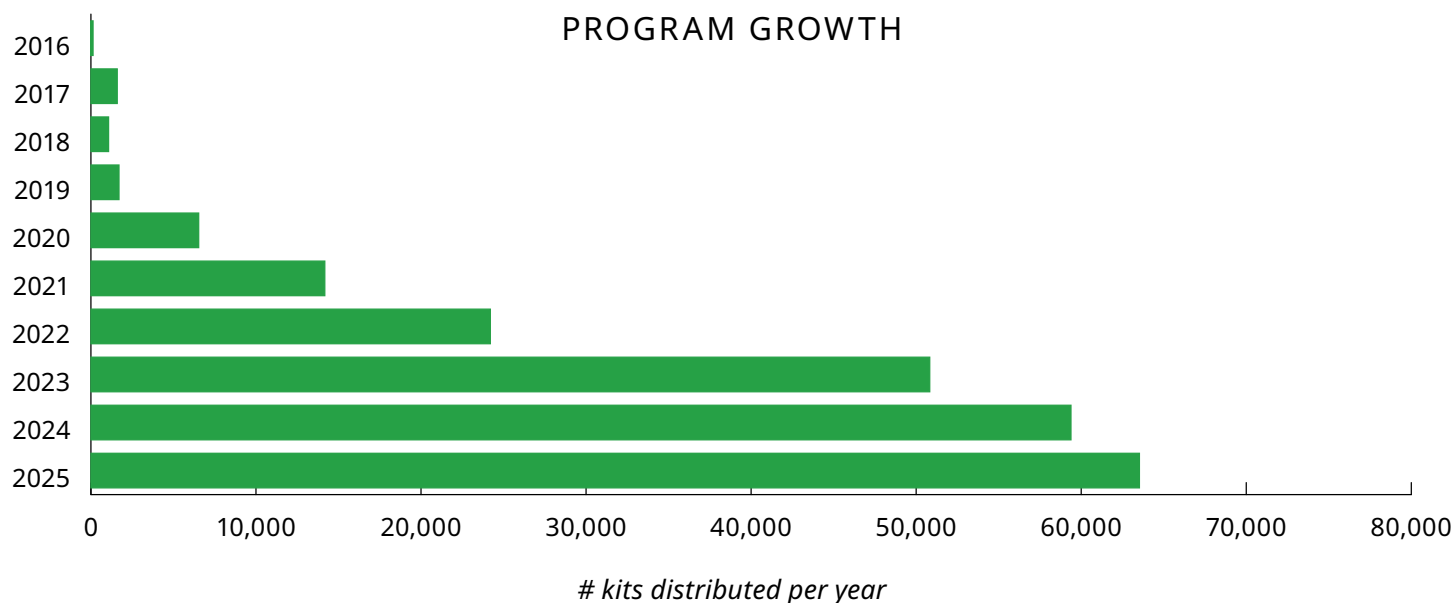
