# **Red Deer Lake**

## **Community Status**

Red Deer Lake is located 8 kilometres north of Barrows, which is on PTH #77 west of Mafeking. Other nearby communities include Baden, Powell, National Mills and Westgate all on PTH #77.

The community of Red Deer Lake developed as a result of the Red Deer Sawmill, which closed in 1927. Today a historic stone vault, from the community bank building, still stands although the rest of the building is gone.

Red Deer Lake is governed by a contact person under *The Northern Affairs Act.*

## **Economic Overview**

Red Deer Lake Mill was closed in 1927 and since that time several small sawmills have operated for short periods of time.

The area is heavily forested and forest harvesting continues to provide some employment with saw logs for some mills and pulp logs going to Tolko Manitoba Inc. at The Pas.


Soils in the area have potential for agricultural development and there is limited ranching.

Trapping continues to be a major source of employment and the community shares traplines in the Porcupine and Shoal River Registered Trap Line Zones with other communities.

Some fishing takes place on Red Deer Lake and other nearby lakes with fishers delivering their catch to Dawson Bay or Red Deer Lake fish stations.
