Pursuant to Rule 27(1), Hon. Mr. EICHLER, Mr. KINEW, Mrs. MAYER, Mr. ALTEMEYER and Hon. Ms. SQUIRES made Members' Statements.

The following petitions were presented and read:

Ms. Lamoureux – Legislative Assembly to urge the Provincial Government to encourage the Federal Government to amend the Canada Health Act by adding prescription medicines prescribed by a licensed practitioner to the definition of covered services in accordance with an established formulary and to develop, jointly with the Federal Government, a universal, single payer, evidence based, sustainable public drug plan that contains: purchasing power to secure best available pricing; a list of essential medicines addressing priority health needs and; the ability to expand to a comprehensive permanent plan that would promote the health and well-being of all Canadians.

Mr. ALTEMEYER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to reverse the cuts and closures that negatively impact patients' ability access to timely, quality health care and to make real investments in Manitoba's public health care system that will provide a direct benefit to patients, such as: increasing access to primary care; the development of a provincial health human resource plan; increasing publicly funded personal care homes across Manitoba; and increasing the efficiencies of diagnostic testing in Manitoba's health facilities.

Following Oral Questions, Mr. KINEW rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding comments made by the First Minister in Question Period which referenced comments made by the member for St. Johns in the House the previous week and moved:

THAT this matter be referred to the Standing Committee on Legislative Affairs.

And Hon. Ms. SQUIRES, having spoken.
