Pursuant to Rule 27(1), Hon. Messrs. GERRARD and WHARTON, Mrs. SMITH (Point Douglas) and Messrs. YAKIMOSKI and NESBITT made Members' Statements.

Following Oral Questions, Hon. Mr. FLETCHER rose on a Matter of Privilege alleging that the Minister of Infrastructure had misled the Committee of Supply by saying that sole sourced contracting had not occurred while in fact it had. He concluded his remarks by moving:
