And Mr. EWASKO moved an amendment as follows:

THAT the Government motion be amended by striking out everything following "commitment to" and replacing that text with "peace and security, and to encouraging negotiations of a ceasefire, including the release of hostages and free provision of aid to end the famine crisis in Israel and Gaza."

WHEREUPON the Speaker ruled the amendment in order,

And a debate arising on the amendment,

And Messrs. GOERTZEN and SCHULER, MLA KHAN, Hon. Min. SCHMIDT and Mrs. COOK having spoken,

And the Question being put on the amendment. It was negatived, on the following division:
