### Twinning Program with Women Parliamentarians Commonwealth Women Parliamentarians - Canada Region

The Manitoba Legislative Assembly is pleased to be hosting a Commonwealth Women Parliamentarians (CWP) *Twinning Program with Women Parliamentarians* on Thursday, May 21 and Friday, May 22, 2026. The program is open to young women ages 17-29 from across Manitoba, who will be “twinned” with women parliamentarians for two days. The objectives of the program include experiencing parliamentary life, generating political interest among young women, and offering women parliamentarians an opportunity to have exchanges with women regarding their concerns and interests.

The Assembly is hosting the two-day program at the Legislative building which will include a variety of events, including meetings with women MLAs, a tour of the Legislative Assembly, experiencing constituency business and observing House proceedings from the Public Gallery.

Travel, accommodation and meals may be provided through the program. Additional details will be provided to selected participants.

**Please note:** Due to limited space in the program, meeting the following requirements is essential to be considered for the selection process.

#### Requirements to apply:

- You must be a woman between the ages of 17 and 29.
- You must be able to commit to attending all activities on both days (May 21-22, 2026).
