Tour Bookings: Please complete the **online reservation form** to book your tour or call the Tour Program Office to reserve your tour time.

Cost: All tours are free of charge

Languages: Tours are offered in English and French throughout the year.

How far in advance do I need to book: Guided tours need to be reserved with a minimum of two weeks advance notice. The majority of our school tours take place between March and June. Requests for guided tours increase when the House is in Session. When the House is not in Session there are fewer school visits and it is often easier to make a reservation. Tours are booked on a first come, first served basis. It is best to contact our office with as much notice as possible to avoid disappointment.

Tour Length: Tour lasts approximately 60 minutes. If you would like to have a shorter tour or have any special requests, we would be happy to accommodate these requests if we can. Visits to the building are longer if they include viewing **Session**. Please contact the Tour Program Office for more information.

Group Size: Guided tours are offered to groups of 10 or more year round. Groups of more than 50 may be divided into two tours, perhaps at different times, on the same day. Hourly tours take place in the summer months from July 1 – Labour Day in September from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm. At this time, groups of 10 or more during these summer months require a tour booking. Please contact the Tour Program Office by phone at (204) 945-5813 to make a reservation, or for more information.

Visitor Information: The Manitoba Legislative Building is a working office building; please remain in the public spaces. We ask visitors to the building to talk quietly while inside the building. Self-guided information is available at the front entrance to the building.

Parking: There is 2 hour free visitor parking on the Legislative Building Grounds. Please be sure to register your license plate with Protective Services Officers at the front desk.

Special Access Requirements: The Manitoba Legislative Building is accessible for visitors in wheelchairs and those with limited mobility or young children in strollers.
