

# ANNUAL POPULATION STATISTICS REPORT

## Manitoba Population Estimates: July 1, 2023

Statistics Canada has released its July 1, 2023 population estimates and July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 demographic estimates for Canada, the provinces, and territories.

According to Statistics Canada, Manitoba's total population was estimated at 1,454,902 residents as of July 1, 2023, an increase of 41,493 individuals, or 2.94%, from the July 1, 2022 estimate of 1,413,409. Manitoba's twelve-month net international and other international levels are modern-day records, however net interprovincial outflows not seen since 1989/90 hamper growth.

Net international migration (immigrants minus short-term and long-term emigrants) continues to be a major contributor to population growth, with Manitoba recording a net gain of 22,934 migrants during the twelve months ending June 30, 2023, up from 18,733 net migrants over the 2021/22 census year. Other international migration (that is, the net change in non-permanent residents plus the number of short-term and long-term returning emigrants) was an estimated net gain of 23,653 migrants for 2022/23. This net gain is up from the net gain of 5,219 other international migrants estimated for 2021/22.

Through interprovincial migration, Manitoba recorded an estimated net loss to other provinces and territories of 10,246 residents during 2022/23. This net loss is larger than the net loss of 7,451 individuals in 2021/22. During 2022/23, Manitoba's largest net gains were from Nunavut (27) and Northwest Territories (12). The largest net losses were to Alberta (-5,108), British Columbia (-2,869) and Ontario (-1,107).

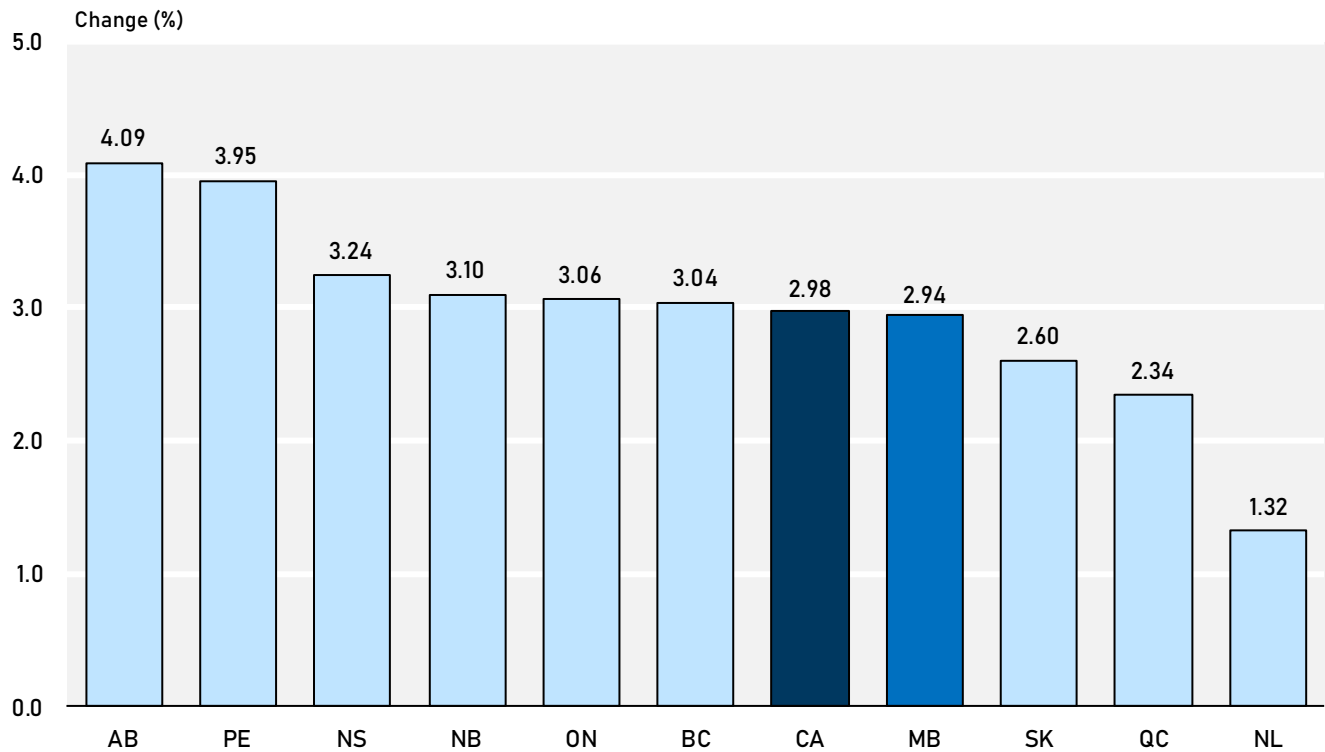
Generally, Manitoba's interprovincial migration losses are offset to some degree by other forms of migration. Combining the various forms of population movement, Manitoba recorded an overall net migration gain of 36,341 people in 2022/23. This net gain marked an increase of 19,840 individuals from the net gain of 16,501 migrants in 2021/22.

Statistics Canada has released revised demographic estimates for the first quarter 2001 onward. This MBS report incorporates all revisions. Tables 5, 6, and 7 present the differences between the current estimates and those previously published by Statistics Canada for Tables 1, 2 and 4.

\*Effective with this release, Emigration and Returning Emigration include both short-term and long-term migrants from July 2016 onward. In previously published data, only long-term migrants were included. Short-term Emigrants and short-term Returning Emigrants were accounted for as Net Temporary Emigrants, part of the Other International Migration component.

Jul 1, 2022 to Jul 1, 2023

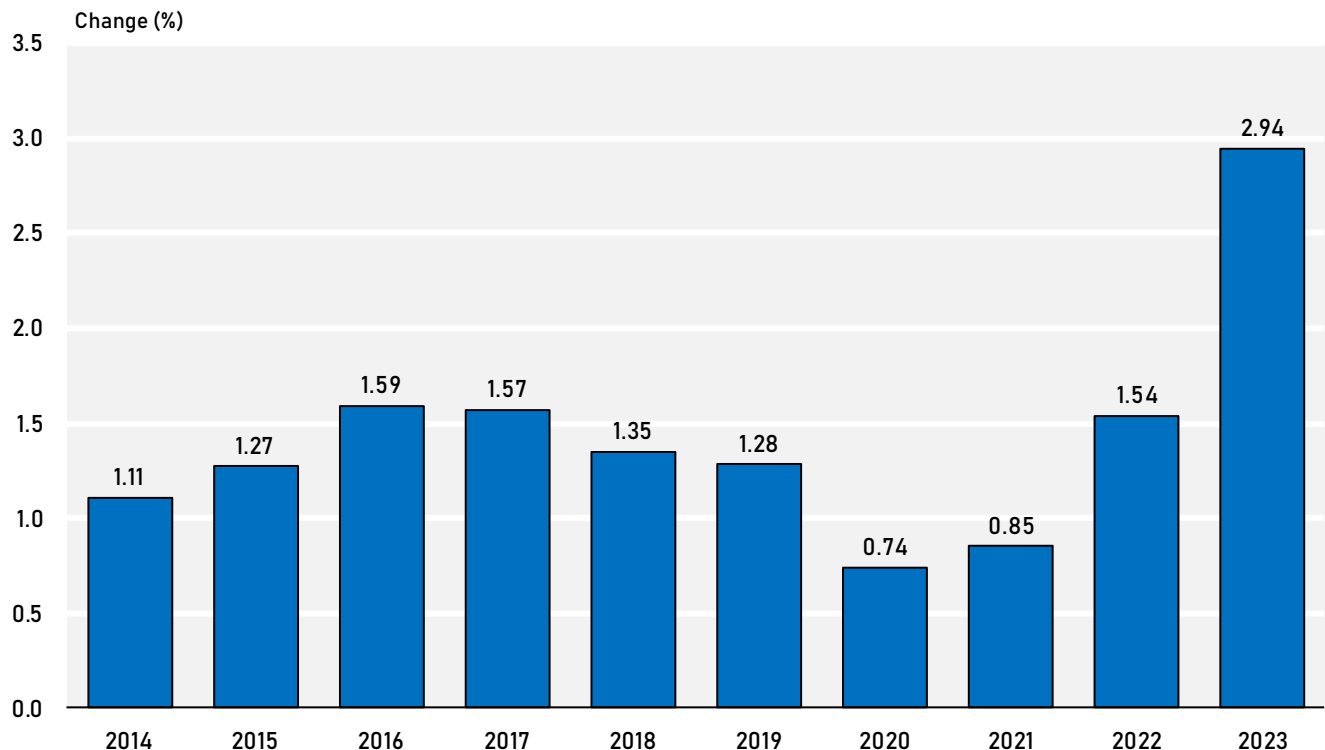

## Notes to Readers

### Regarding COVID-19

On March 18, 2020 the Government of Canada implemented travel restrictions aimed at reducing the spread of COVID-19. Slight modifications are being made to the estimation methods for Emigrants and Returning Emigrants to ensure that pandemic effects are not carried forward into future estimates. No other COVID-19 related adjustments are being made at this time.

### Birth Registration Issues

Birth estimation methods have been adjusted due to data availability issues for Nova Scotia (August to December 2021) and Manitoba (January 2021 onward).

### Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET)

Since March 17, 2022, persons with a Canada-Ukraine authorization for emergency travel who are on Canadian soil are included in the Net Non-permanent Resident estimates.

## Revisions

### Census Base

Effective with this release, Postcensal estimates are based on the 2021 Census counts adjusted for census net undercoverage and for incompletely enumerated reserves and settlements.

### Emigration and Returning Emigration

Effective with this release, Emigrants and Returning Emigrants include both long-term and short-term migrants from July 2016 onward. Prior to July 2016, only long-term migrants are included.

### Net Temporary Emigration

Effective with this release, from July 2016 onward, short-term Emigrants and short-term Returning Emigrants are included with Emigrants and Returning Emigrants respectively, and the Net Temporary Emigrant component is no longer being provided. Prior to July 2016, short-term Emigrants and short-term Returning Emigrants were accounted for as Net Temporary Emigrants, part of the Other International Migration component.

### Non-permanent Residents

Effective with this release, from July 2021 onward, estimation methods for non-permanent residents have been adjusted to better account for open work permits without a province/territory of intended destination, permit processing delays and dependents of permit-holders.
