

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BY THE MUNICIPAL BOARD OF MANITOBA**

**RE: RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF EAST ST. PAUL – SECONDARY PLAN BY-LAW NO. 2025-10
OBJECTION TO SECONDARY PLAN BY-LAW FROM THE PUBLIC
FILE NO. 26B8 - 0001**

IN THE MATTER OF: The Rural Municipality of East St. Paul (the “Municipality”) proposes to establish the East St. Paul Secondary Plan By-law No. 2025-10 (the “Proposed By-law”). The Proposed By-law seeks to provide direction for the development of lands that are generally located south and east of PTH 59.

AND IN THE MATTER OF: Objections from the Public to the Proposed By-law received by the Municipality and referral of the Objections to The Municipal Board (the “Board”) under Sections 77(5) and 77.1 (1) of *The Planning Act*.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that, under the provisions of *The Planning Act*, C.C.S.M. c. P80, and *The Municipal Board Act*, C.C.S.M. c. M240, the Board will hold a public hearing to receive representations from any person on the objections regarding the Proposed By-law.

The public hearing will take place on **Wednesday, September 9, 2026** and, if needed, on **Thursday, September 10, 2026** and **Friday, September 11, 2026**, at **9:30 a.m.** at the **Sunova Centre, 48 Holland Road, West St. Paul, Manitoba**.

Any interested person may make a representation on the matter to be considered at the hearing. A person who wishes to make a written and/or oral presentation to the Board must register by filing a completed Public Presenter Form with the Board at least ten (10) working days prior to the hearing.

The Board requires that an interested person who intends on filing a written submission must file four (4) copies of that material with the Board and one (1) copy with the Rural Municipality of East St. Paul for public viewing at least ten (10) working days prior to the hearing, failing which copies of the written submission must be provided to the Board and the parties at the hearing.
