SAFETY TALK

Winter Personal Protective Equipment

With extremely cold winter weather conditions it is important to wear properly rated winter clothing.

HAZARDS

- Non-rated work gloves, parkas, pants and coveralls, poorly insulated work boots and not wearing proper fleece helmet liners under hard hats can expose you to serious health and safety injury during the cold winter season

SAFEGUARDS

Check your body protection and ensure the following is in place:

- Protective gloves/mitts rated for extreme cold weather conditions
- Thermal insulated high visibility coveralls or parka/pants that are rated for protection from extreme cold weather conditions
- Insulated steel toe boots with thermal socks
- Fleece helmet liners under hard hat, they are a good insulator. The longer the liner the better the protective from cold weather elements
