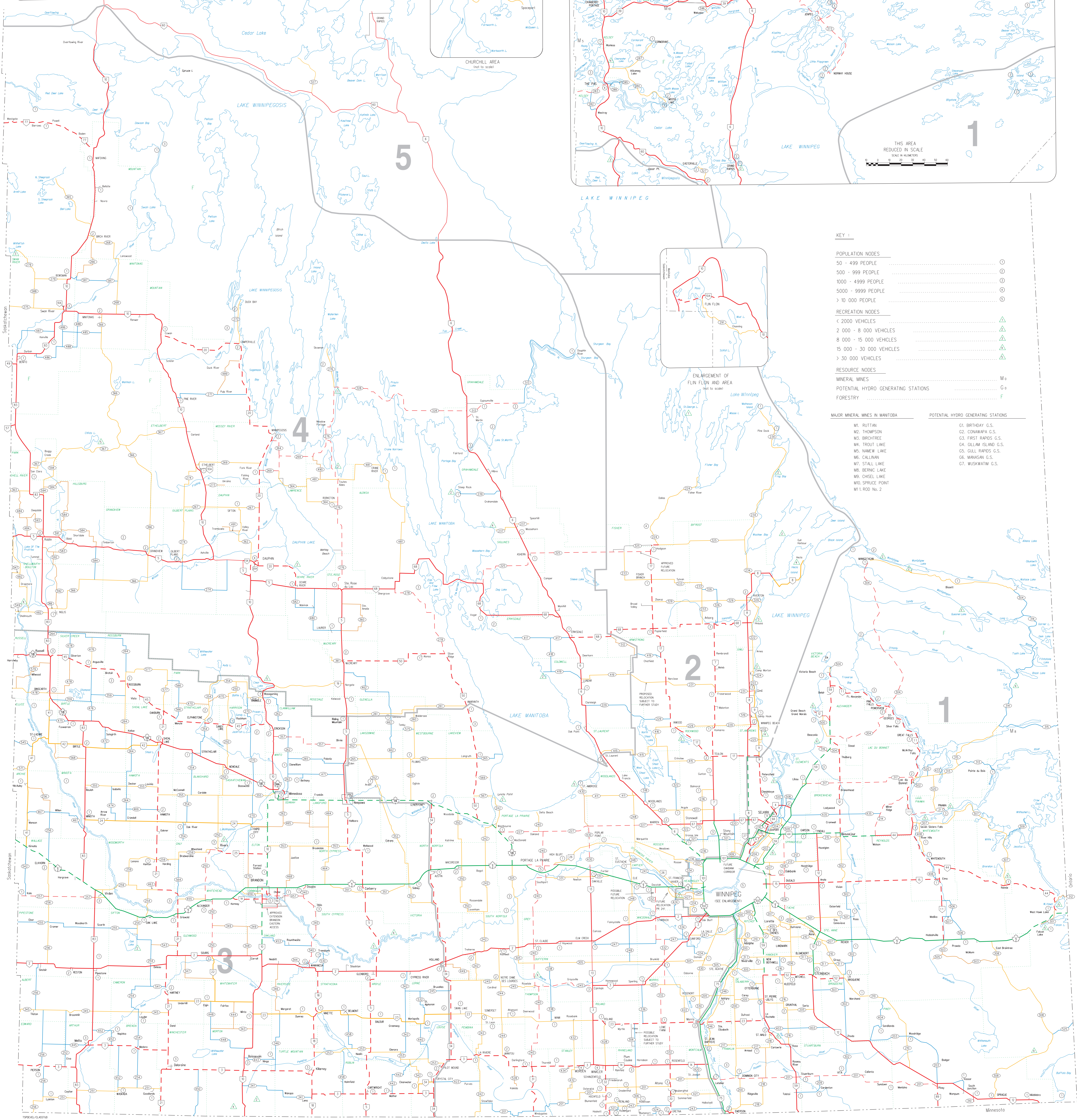
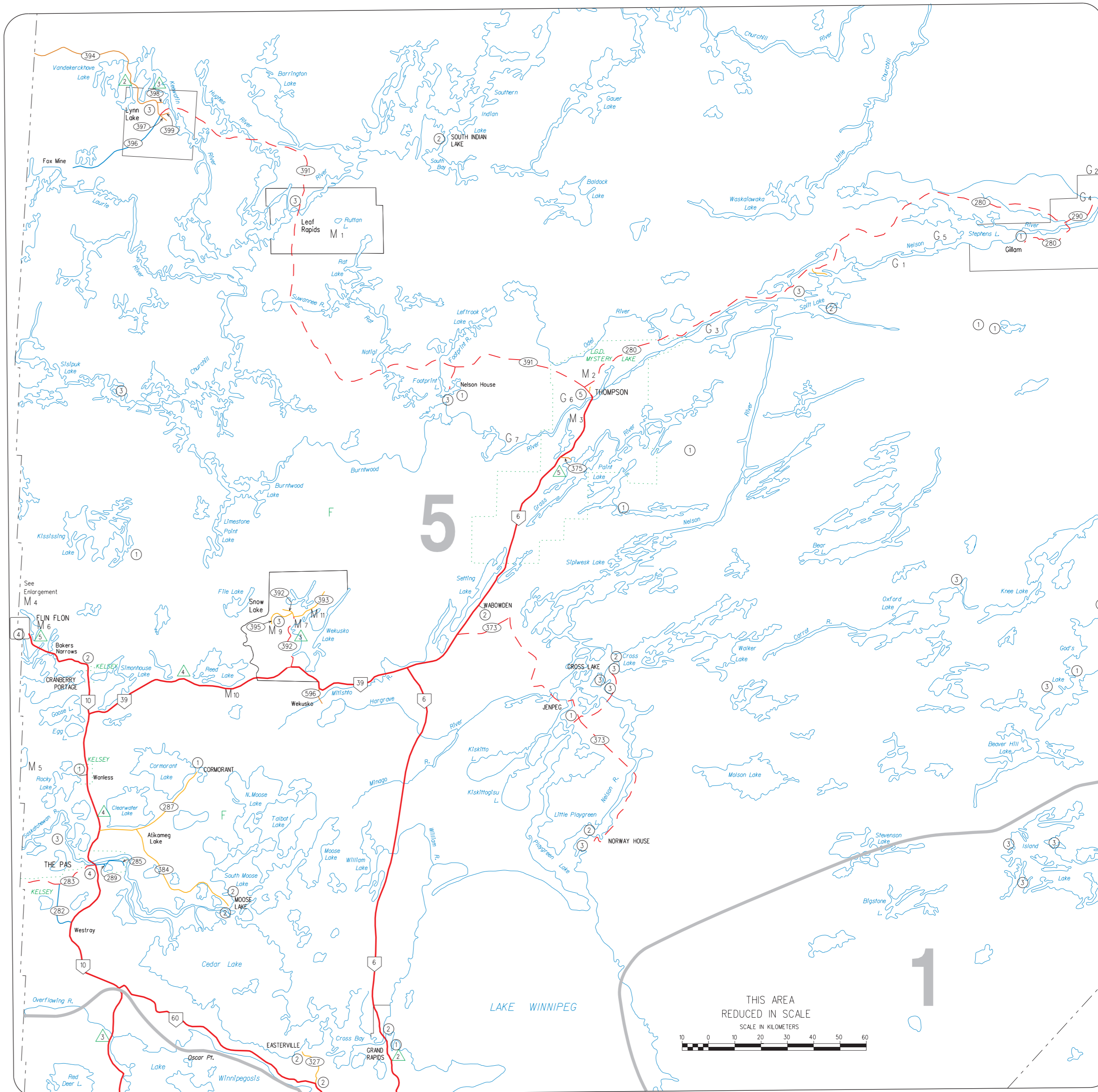
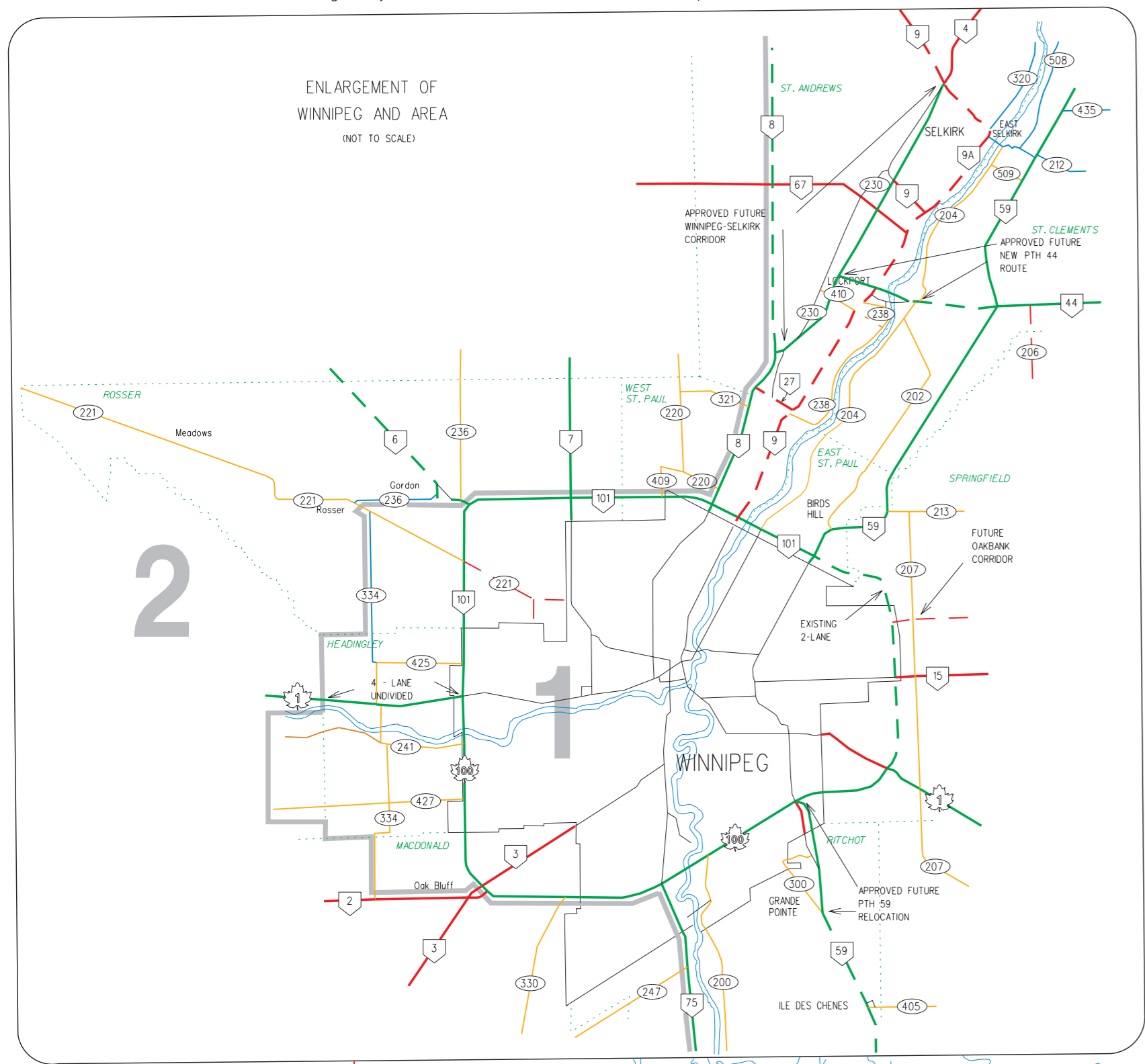
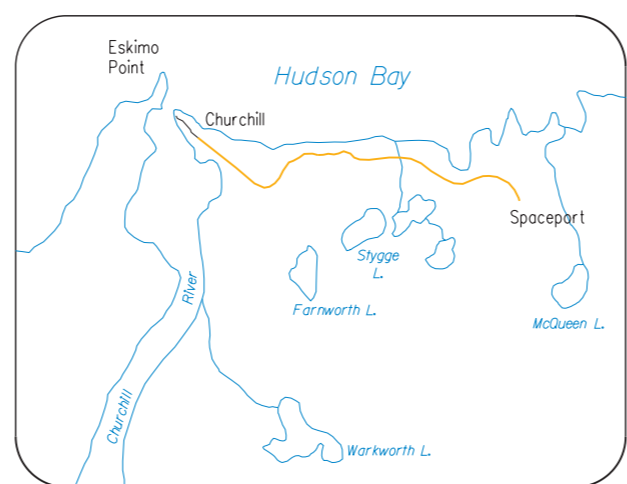
PROVINCIAL ROAD FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION
