THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

ALTERNATIVE AUTO PARTS/W. DUANE SOMERVILLE: APPLICANT

The following limits, terms, and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction and operation of an auto wrecking facility located on Part of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23-10-26 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Wallace:


1. The Applicant shall collect all drained fluids (gasoline, antifreeze, crankcase and differential fluids) and safely store the fluids in water-tight and covered drums prior to re-use or disposal.
2. The Applicant shall ensure each drum in which fluids are stored is clearly marked on the side and on the top surface identifying the type of fluid therein.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that periodic disposal of liquids collected will be made by delivery to a facility that is approved to safely recycle or destroy such liquids.
4. The Applicant shall maintain a written record of such disposal mentioned in item 3; recording the date, quantity, and type of liquid removed for disposal and the location of such disposal.
5. The Applicant shall ensure that no open burning of any material related to the auto wrecking operation takes place within the auto wrecking facility site.

6. The Applicant shall ensure the orderly placement of vehicles on the area set aside for this purpose and shall ensure that an open space exists on all four sides of each vehicle to allow ease in maintenance of the entire area to assure a clean, tidy, rodent and weed free storage area.
7. The Applicant shall provide to the Director a copy of the development agreement to be entered into between himself and the Rural Municipality of Wallace in its entirety.
