THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

MINNEDOSA FISH ENHANCEMENT COMMITTEE: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a rock groin and fish screen upstream of the spillway of the Minnedosa Dam in NE 1-15-18W in the Town of Minnedosa, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct and operate the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated November 18, 1994.
- 2. The Licencee shall not undertake construction activities on the groin portion of the Development between April 1 and June 15 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall ensure that material used in the construction of the groin does not contain fine material which would aggravate sedimentation in Minnedosa Lake.
- 4. The Licencee shall ensure that placement of the groin does not reduce the hydraulic capacity of the spillway of the Minnedosa Dam.
- 5. The Licencee shall ensure that the fish screen portion of the Development is maintained in good working order, and that appropriate maintenance activities are undertaken.
- 6. The Licencee shall ensure that timber used in the Development is not treated with creosote or penta chlorol phenols.
- 7. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction and operation of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with all applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 8. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
