IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANITOBA ENVIRONMENT ACT (C.C.S.M. c. E125)  
THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 11(1) TO:

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF  
HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION; "the Licencee"**

for the construction, operation and maintenance of the Development being the upgrading of 10.4 km of Provincial Road 262 from Provincial Trunk Highway 10 east of Onanole to Rolling River in the Rural Municipalities of Park and Clanwilliam and in accordance with the Proposal filed under The Environment Act on November 30, 1998 and subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

**DEFINITIONS**

In this Licence:

**"wetlands"** means those areas where the water table is at or above the land surface for a long enough period each year to make the area capable of supporting aquatic or hydrophilic vegetation, and which have soils with characteristics indicative of wet conditions.

**GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

This Section of the Licence contains requirements intended to provide guidance to the Licencee in implementing practices to ensure that the environment is maintained in such a manner as to sustain a high quality of life, including social and economic development, recreation and leisure for present and future Manitobans.

1. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that any fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from waterbodies including wetlands and ensure the storage areas comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R - Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
