

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and ALLAN CARRUTHERS, Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Allan Carruthers filed an application with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with an automobile wrecking operation known as A & J Salvage, located on the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 9, Township 56, Range 25 WPM in the Local Government District of Consol, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 11th day of September, 1978;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that the site of the active area of the said operation is effectively screened from the view of persons using the adjacent municipal road.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that all scrap parts including, but not limited to, scrap metal parts, cars, tires, engines, used oil, batteries, are stored within the confines of the site of the active area of operation.
3. The Applicant shall ensure vehicular access to the site of the active area of the said operation through the provision of an all-weather road.



4. The Applicant shall ensure that all liquid wastes from the said operation are handled and controlled in such a manner as to prevent the contamination of surface water and groundwater at any point off the site of the said operation.
5. The Applicant shall ensure that there is no burning of any materials on the site of the said operation of such a nature as to impede visibility at the seaplane base or create nuisance conditions in the vicinity of the said operation.
6. The Applicant shall ensure that all wastes other than vehicles and usable parts therefrom are removed from the site of the said operation on a regular basis and deposited at a waste disposal ground.
