

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and ALFALFA PRODUCTS LIMITED, Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Alfalfa Products Limited filed an application with the department of Mines, Natural Resources and Environment in connection with the operation of an alfalfa feed pelletizing plant located on part of Lot 63, St. Boniface OTM in Fort Whyte in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation issued under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS no representations were received from persons who are or who may be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits on the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 19th day of February, 1979;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that, on and after the 1st day of June, 1980:
 - (a) particulate matter emissions from various processes of the said operation do not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury;
 - (b) visible emissions do not exceed an opacity of:
 - (i) 40 percent for a period exceeding 4 minutes in any one hour period at the point of emission;
 - (ii) 60 percent at any time at the point of emission.

2. The Applicant shall ensure that, on and after the 1st day of June, 1981, the odour emanating from the said operation is not detectable at any point of impingement in a residential area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with one volume of odour-free air.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that particulate matter from any source of the said operation does not become airborne to such an extent that the particulate matter remains visible past the property line of the said operation.
4. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times, consistent with meeting the requirements of Clauses 1, 2 and 3 of this Order.
