HYLIFE FOODS LP - PORK PROCESSING PLANT EXPANSION - FILE: 2754.10

A proposal was filed on behalf of HyLife Foods LP for the expansion and operation of the HyLife Foods pork processing plant located in the southwest quarter of Section 35, Township 14, Range 15 WPM in the Town of Neepawa. The proposed changes to the development include an increase in the current production rate of 27,550 hogs per week to 37,500 hogs per week as well as the addition of a casings and heparin production operation. The increase in wastewater which would result from the proposed increased production rate would be accommodated by a proposed expansion at the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility (IWWTF) which treats the wastewater generated at the pork processing plant and is owned by R3 Innovations and the Town of Neepawa. A separate proposal has been filed for the IWWTF expansion.
