Re: Notice of Alteration - Extension of Environment Act Licence No. 2302 ER

Thank you for your request dated July 6, 2023, seeking to extend the expiry of Environment Act Licence No. 2302 ER (licence) to December 31, 2026. The licence currently expires on December 31, 2024.

I amend clause 44 of the licence following section 14(2) of The Environment Act and I approve the licence to be in effect until December 31, 2026. All other clauses of this licence remain in effect.

The extension aligns with the expiry date of Canadian Kraft Paper and Nisokapawino Forestry Management Corporation's Forest Management License Agreement. This extension will allow for completion of the Forest Management Plan and related engagement and consultation processes, and Manitoba's technical review of the plan.
