**Re: Environment Act Licence 1687**

This letter is a follow-up regarding the correspondence dated April 28, 2014 pertaining to Environment Act Licence 1687, issued on June 28, 1993, for a crop protection products warehouse and distribution facility, a seed cleaning operation, a bulk liquid fertilizer and a bulk dry fertilizer facility located on the N ½ of 07-18-28 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Ellice.

Upon further review of your facility, it is my understanding that there is a residence owned by an individual other than the licensee within 500 metres of your operation. Due to this new information, your facility still meets the requirements of the *Classes of Development Regulation (M.R. 164/88)*.

Based on this new information, I am hereby reinstating Environment Act Licence 1687.
