Re: Notice of Alteration - Extension of Environment Act Licence No. 2191 E

Thank you for your request dated June 27, 2024, seeking to extend the expiry of Environment Act Licence No. 2191 E (licence) to August 30, 2029. The licence currently expires on June 30, 2024.

I amend clause 37 of the licence following section 14(2) of The Environment Act and I approve the licence to be in effect until August 30, 2029. All other clauses of this licence remain in effect.

The extension allows time for Manitoba to work with Minegoziibe Anishinaabe, Wuskwi Sipihk First Nation, and Sapotaweyak Cree Nation to implement a draft agreement supporting the development of a renewed, collaborative approach to stewardship and forestry management and planning for FML 3. This process is intended to create a new Forest Management Plan (FMP). Following the approval of the company's new FMP, Manitoba will make a decision on the renewal of the Forest Management Licence Agreement and Environment Act Licence.

Anyone affected by this decision may appeal, in writing, to the Minister of Environment and Climate Change at minecc@manitoba.ca by July 27, 2024. The licence is available on the public registry at https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/3893lp/index.html
