**Re: GFL Kenaston Facility - Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act
Licence No. 334 HW - Alteration Approval**

Thank you for your alteration requests dated March 8, 2023, and July 17, 2023, and additional information dated December 21, 2023. You seek to:

1. remove Ringwood Environmental Inc. Model CE-400 wastewater treatment system from Building B
2. install an additional 50,000-litre aboveground double-wall tank to store used oil
3. install a shedder to shred solid waste

I approve items 1 and 2 of your requests in accordance with clause 109 of the licence with the following conditions:

- Clause 58 of the licence must be read as
“The licensee shall not have more than the following tanks within the main tank farm:
 - a) six – 120,000 litre vertical storage tanks identified as Tanks K1 to K6;
 - b) six – 124,500 litre vertical storage tanks identified as Tanks K7 to K12; and
 - c) two – 640,000 litre vertical storage tanks identified as Tanks F1 and F2.

- Clause 60 of the licence must be read as
“The licensee shall not have more than the following tanks in proximity to Building A:
 - a) one – 5,000 litre filter press waste oil aboveground storage tank identified as FPT1;
 - b) one – 4,510 litre aboveground storage tank identified as S1; and
 - c) two – 50,000 litre horizontal storage tanks identified as Tanks B1 and B2.”

- Clause 88 of the licence must be read as
“The licensee shall send all wastewater generated at the facility for disposal to a licensed wastewater treatment facility.”
- Item 3 of your request needs a waste management facility permit following the Waste Management Facilities Regulation under The Environment Act for accepting, handling, storing, and processing of non-hazardous solid waste. GFL must submit a permit application to the Director of Environmental Approvals Branch at EABDirector@gov.mb.ca and obtain approval before beginning the shredding operation. All other clauses of the licence and the alteration approval dated January 24, 2023, remain in effect. This alteration approval is available on the public registry at <https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/index.html>. Schedule A of this approval identifies the updated facility layout.
