

On 22 February 2024, GFL received a Notice of Alteration (NoA) related to the installation of a new 50,000L aboveground double walled tank (AST) at the GFL Facility (the Facility) located at 1090 Kenaston Boulevard in Winnipeg Manitoba. This tank is referenced in Clause 60 of the *Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act*, Licence No. 334HW (the Licence). There was a NoA issued in January 2023 related to alterations in the tanks located in Building B at the Facility. These tanks are referred to in Clause 62 of the Licence.

Clause 62 of the Licence, reads:

- 62. The licensee must not have more than the following tanks within Building B:*
- a) three -12,000 litre vertical poly tanks identified as tanks T1, T2, and T3*
  - b) three -20,000 litre vertical poly tanks identified as tanks T4, T6, and T7*
  - c) one -10,000 litre cone bottom poly tank identified as tank T8*
  - d) one -22,000 litre vertical poly tank identified as tank T9*
  - e) two -31,000 litre vertical steel tanks identified as tanks S1 and S2*
  - f) two -11,356 litre cone bottom poly tanks identified as tanks T10 and T11*

GFL is seeking to alter the Licence with respect to the configuration of the tanks located in Building B. Tanks identified in items a, b, c, d, and e are being removed from Building B in their entirety. Tanks T10 and T11 (item f) will be the only tanks left in this building.

As part of the alteration, the AST that was approved under the February 2024 NoA, will be relocated into Building B. Currently this tank is listed under Clause 60 of the Licence and will need to be moved into Clause 62.

A new schematic outlining the location of the tanks at the Facility is attached.

The removal of the tanks in Building B is expected to occur within the next few months. These tanks will be decommissioned and disposed of in accordance with regulatory requirements.

Environmental impacts related to removal and addition of tank(s) are minor in nature. Therefore, this would be considered a minor alteration.

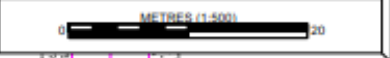
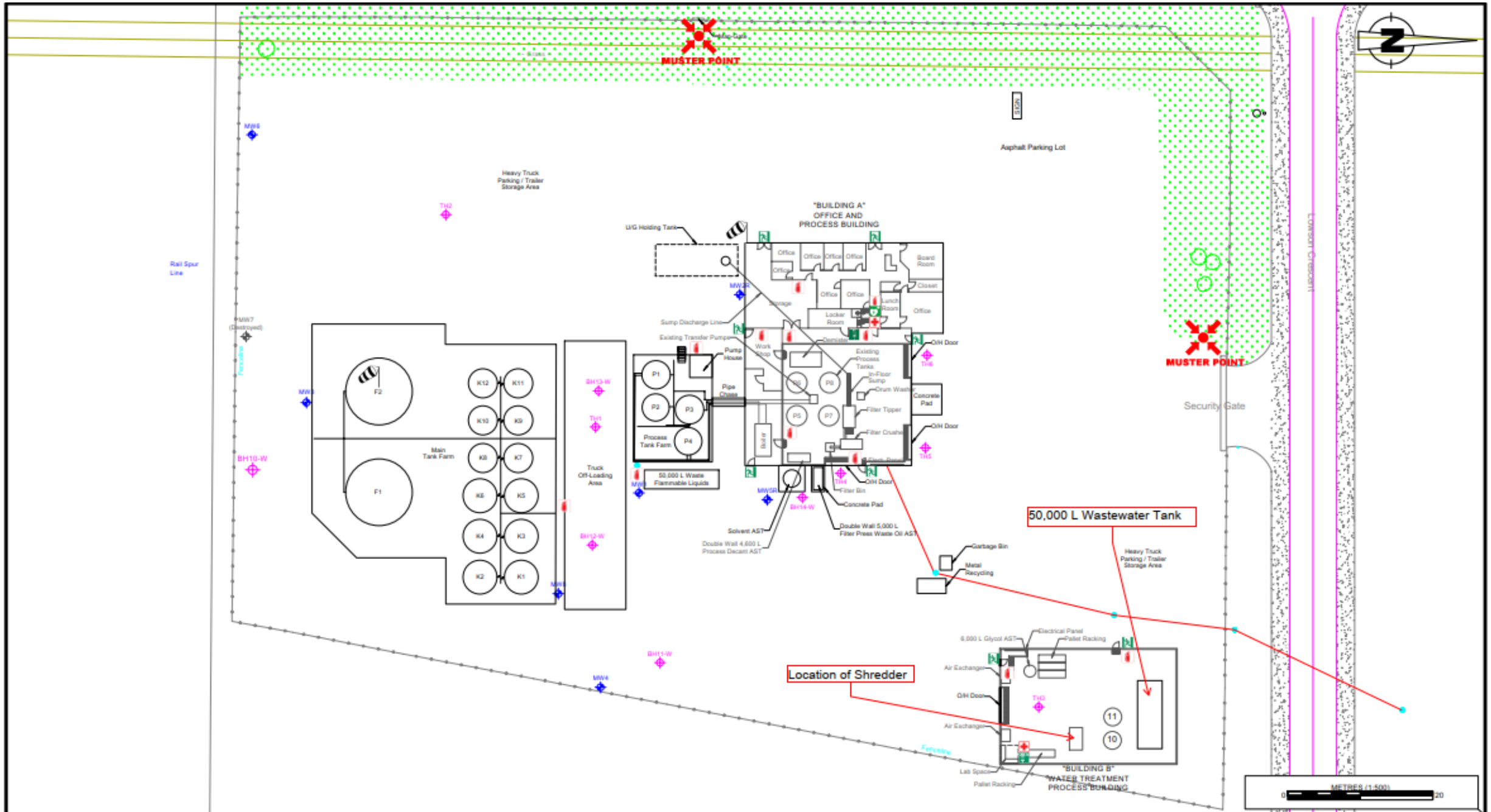
