Good morning Cameron,

Further to our telephone conversation regarding the fate of process tanks P5 to P8, we are writing to request clarification and updates to the submitted Notice of Alteration (NoA) documentation.

Upon reviewing the following documents submitted in support of the Notice of Alteration for the GFL Kenaston Facility, we noted an inconsistency regarding the final disposition of process tanks P5 to P8:

1. the March 18, 2025 NoA does not include tanks P5 to P8 in the list of tanks to be removed;
2. the May 22, 2025 response letter states that there are no changes to tanks P5 to P8; and
3. the June 27, 2025 discussion document indicates that tanks P5 to P8 are to be removed by December 31, 2025.

To ensure clarity and consistency in the regulatory review process, we kindly request that you update the documentation so that all three documents reflect a consistent and accurate statement regarding the final fate of tanks P5 to P8.

Please confirm whether these tanks are to remain in service or be decommissioned and revise the documents accordingly.
