RE: City of Thompson – City of Thompson Wastewater Treatment Plant – Minor Notice of Alteration Approval – Environment Act Licence No. 3118 R

I am responding to the April 26, 2019 Notice of Alteration request, submitted by you, relative to a request for alteration to Clause 13(b) of Environment Act Licence No. 3118 R (Licence), originally issued for the construction and operation of the Development being a wastewater collection system and a wastewater treatment plant located on Lot C, Plan 4657 in Township 78 and Range 3 WPM in the City of Thompson. The submission is considered a Notice of Alteration (NoA) pursuant to Section 14 of The Environment Act.

The intent of the NoA is to alter the completion of the construction and commissioning of the new wastewater treatment plant from July 31, 2017 to July 2019.

Upon review of the NoA and pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Environment Act, I hereby amend Clause 13 of the Licence as follows:

13. The Licencee shall:

- a) submit progress reports every month from the date of this approval until final commissioning summarizing the design, construction and commissioning of the wastewater treatment plant;
- b) complete the construction and commissioning of the wastewater treatment plant on or before August 30, 2019;
- c) take one flow proportional composite sample of effluent from the effluent monitoring station of the existing wastewater treatment plant operating under Environment Act Licence No. 2589 from the date of this letter to approved commissioning of the new wastewater treatment plant during discharge period once each week;

- d) take a grab sample of effluent from the existing aerated wastewater treatment lagoon operating under Environment Act Licence No. 30 from the date of this letter to approved commissioning of the new wastewater treatment plant during discharge period once each week;
- e) have the flow proportional composite sample analyzed for total phosphorus;
- f) have the grab sample analyzed for total phosphorus;
- g) submit a report on total phosphorus discharge from the existing wastewater treatment plant and the existing aerated wastewater treatment lagoon to the Director of Environmental Approvals Branch on or before September 30, 2019.

All other clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 3118 R remain in effect.
