**Reference: Lynn Lake Gold Project, Environment Act Proposals, Lynn Lake, MB**

On behalf of Alamos Gold Inc. (Alamos), enclosed are two separate Environment Act Proposal (EAP) Summary Reports for the MacLellan and Gordon mine sites, which together form the Lynn Lake Gold Project. The Project consists of the development of two open pit gold mines and associated infrastructure on former mine sites in northern Manitoba (near Lynn Lake). Alamos understands that the two gold mines and associated infrastructure are considered Class 2 developments as per the Classes of Development Regulation MR 164/88, requiring two complete and separate EAPs.

These documents are submitted for review by the Environmental Approvals Branch in order to obtain approval for the construction and operation of the Project.
