KETTLE GENERATING STATION – SHORT-TERM EXTENSION LICENCE

We request a five-year Short-Term Extension Licence (STEL) for the Kettle Generating Station under the provisions of Section 92 of Water Power Regulation 25/88R. We have included a Short-Term Extension Report as supporting documentation and will continue to work with your Branch to address this Water Power licence. This support document highlights the following key items:

- Project Components
- Water Power Licensing Requirements
- Monitoring Programs
- Community Involvement, System Upgrades and Studies

Manitoba Hydro operates the Kettle Generating Station in accordance with the Final Licence for the Development of Water Power at the Kettle Rapids site on the Nelson River. This licence is in effect until November 1, 2022.

Manitoba Hydro requested a Renewal Licence on September 8, 2017. Manitoba Hydro intends to submit the technical requirements for completing the Renewal Licence for Kettle Generating Station to Manitoba Environment, Climate and Parks within the term of the STEL.
